Copperfield School's 1st annual Rainbow Trout release is
Friday June 1, 2018



Dear Families,

In partnership with the Bow Habitat Station, we have been diligently raising Rainbow Trout from eggs and they will finally be ready to live in the wild in June. All Copperfield School families are invited to participate in releasing them!

The actual release will take about 30 minutes to an hour (but can be as short or long as you want to make it). Representatives from the Bow Habitat Station and Alberta Environment and Parks will be in attendance to help us with releasing the trout, and answering any questions you may have. We are requesting that **Copperfield students only** have the opportunity to release fish first, and should there be any left, siblings are absolutely welcome to release one as well.

Feel free to bring a picnic lunch and fishing rods, and whomever you like! Grandparents, siblings, cousins, and pets are all welcome. Please remember to bring your fishing licenses

if you are over the age of 16 and plan on fishing (Children under the age of 16 do not require a fishing license).

The release will go ahead as scheduled, rain or shine, so if you choose to come, please dress for all kinds of mountain weather (and maybe a change of clothes if you get a little too enthusiastic when letting the trout go).

Please be aware that this is **not** a CBE or school-hosted event, so parents will be fully responsible for their own children. There is no cost involved.

Where: Sibbald Meadows Pond, Kananaskis Country. Google Maps finds it easily. We recommend going through Bragg Creek.

When: Friday, June 1 2018, at 1:00 pm.

It is recommended that you leave right after dismissal from the school to get to the pond on time.
